- Downtown Los Angeles City Hall was built in 1924.
- MGM Grand lent all its lighting equipment to officials for the opening Ceremony of City Hall in 1928.
- City Hall has been on the Los Angeles Police Department's badge since 1940.
- Until 1964 City Hall was the tallest structure in Los Angeles.

The residents took a tour of the Downtown Los Angeles City Hall on November 8. The tour started at the entrance hall at 200 Spring Street. During the walk thru the courtyard before the main entrance, the residents admired the Greco- Roman architecture of the columns and arches. Entering the building you can't help but notice the beautifully preserved 1920's elevator with the sign "Express Cars Only" above it. The tour continued into the Hall of Mayors where the paintings of the city's mayors are. Each painting had a brief description of the mayor and the office term.
